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# 6A The power to impose a suspension, restriction, condition limitation or disciplinary prohibition

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- (4) The impact of suspension, restriction, condition or disciplinary prohibition on the person in breach

The following considerations may be relevant to the assessment of the impact of suspension or restriction on an *authorised person, sponsor,* <del>or</del> *primary information provider* <u>or *non-*</u> *authorised parent undertaking*:

- (a) the authorised person's, sponsor's, or primary information provider's, or non-authorised parent <u>undertaking's</u> expected lost revenue and profits from not being able to carry out the suspended or restricted activity;
- (b) the cost of any measures the *authorised person*, *sponsor*, <del>or</del> *primary information provider* <u>or *non-authorised parent*</u> <u>undertaking</u> must undertake to comply with the suspension or restriction;
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- (d) the effect on other areas of the *authorised person's*, sponsor's, <del>or</del> primary information provider's <u>or non-</u> <u>authorised parent undertaking's</u> business; and
- (e) whether the suspension or restriction would cause the *authorised person*, *sponsor*, <del>or</del> *primary information provider* <u>or *non-authorised parent undertaking*</u> serious financial hardship.

The following considerations may be relevant to the assessment of the impact of suspension or condition on an *approved person* or the impact of a disciplinary prohibition <u>or restriction</u> on an individual:

6A.3.3 G The *FCA* may delay the commencement of the period of suspension, restriction or disciplinary prohibition. In deciding whether this is

appropriate, the *FCA* will take into account all the circumstances of a case. Considerations that may be relevant in respect of an *authorised person, sponsor*, or *primary information provider* or *non-authorised parent undertaking* include:

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- (2) any practical measures the *authorised person*, *sponsor*, <del>or</del> *primary information provider* <u>or *non-authorised parent*</u> <u>undertaking</u> needs to take before the period of suspension or restriction begins, for example, changes to its systems and controls to enable it to stop or limit the activity in question;
- (3) the impact of the suspension or restriction on other costs incurred by the *authorised person*, *sponsor* or *primary information provider* or *non-authorised parent undertaking*, for example, cancelling suppliers or suspending employees.
