Subject:	Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) 2019/881 as regards managed security services
	- Optional consultation of the Committee of the Regions

- On 18 April 2023, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) 2019/881 as regards managed security services<sup>1</sup>.
- 2. In its proposal, the Commission suggests that the Committee of the Regions be consulted on an optional basis.
- 3. Article 114 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, on which the proposal is based, does not require the opinion of the Committee of the Regions.<sup>2</sup>

- 4. Nevertheless, given the subject matter of the proposal, it is considered appropriate to consult the Committee of the Regions on an optional basis. The proposal aims at raising the level of cybersecurity by enabling the adoption of European cybersecurity certification schemes for managed security services. Managed security services play an important role in assisting entities at national and regional level in their efforts to prevent, detect, respond to or recover from cybersecurity incidents. Furthermore, this proposal amends Regulation (EU) 2019/881 on which the opinion of the Committee of the Regions was already requested in 2017<sup>3</sup>. The Committee of the Regions decided to include its opinion on Regulation (EU) 2019/881 into its opinion on "Digital Single Market: Mid-term review". The Council was informed thereof by letter dated 22 December 2017<sup>4</sup>.
- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore invited to decide, in accordance with Articles 304 and 307 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union and Article 19(7)(h) of the Council's Rules of Procedure<sup>5</sup>, to consult the Committee of the Regions on the above proposal and to request it to give its opinion as soon as possible.
